Mae'r gadwyn gyflenwi bwyd a diod (CGBD) yn bwysig iawn i economi Cymru o ran swyddi, incwm a'r cyfraniad y mae'n ei wneud i dwristiaeth. Mae'r CGBD yn cyflogi oddeutu 230,000 o bobl (18% o holl weithlu Cymru, sy'n golygu ei bod y diwydiant cyflogi cyfunedig mwyaf yng Nghymru gyfan), sydd ar y cyd yn cyfrannu oddeutu £6.5bn o refeniw gwerthiant yn flynyddol. Mae bod â'r sgiliau iawn yn eu lle i yrru'r CGBD yn ei blaen yn hanfodol er mwyn i Gymru a'r economi drwyddi draw elwa cymaint ag y bo modd.

The food and drink supply chain (FDSC) is very important to the Welsh economy in terms of employment, income and the contribution it makes to tourism. The FDSC employs approximately 230,000 people (18% of the total Welsh workforce making it the largest combined industry of employment across Wales), collectively contributing in the region of £6.5bn of sales revenue annually. Having the right skills in place to drive the FDSC forward is essential to maximising its benefits to Wales and the economy overall.

Over the last few months the four Sector Skills Councils representing the land-

Yn ystod yr wythnos mae gwahoddiad i fusnesau ac unigolion ymweld ag adeilad Lantra sydd ar faes y sioe i drafod gyda'r tîm rhai o brif ganfyddiadau ac argymhellion yr arolwg hyd yma. Bydd cyfle hefyd i gael te a choffi a darganfod mwy am Lantra Cymru a'r hyn sydd ganddynt i'w gynnig yng Nghymru.

based and environmental industries (Lantra), food and drink manufacturing (Improve Ltd), tourism and hospitality (People 1st Cymru) and retail (Skillsmart Retail) have undertaken extensive research by carrying out a survey of over 3,000 employers across the Welsh food and drink supply chain. The research, now being finalised, has provided the project with a better understanding of what training skills developments are needed over the next decade.

During the week businesses and individuals are invited to visit the Lantra building situated on the showground to discuss with the team some of the key findings and recommendations from the survey to date. There will also be an opportunity for tea and coffee and to find out more about Lantra Wales and what it has to offer in Wales.
