The Chair of the Food and Farming Panel is Dr Haydn Edwards, Chair of the Food & Drinks Advisory Panel, Welsh Government. The Panel's work will be to represent the sector by providing the best advice, information, and proposals to the Welsh Government and thereby ensure the future

The food and drink supply chain is important to the Welsh economy in terms of employment, income and the contribution it makes to tourism. Recent project research has shown that the supply chain employs 18% of the Welsh workforce (230,000 people) and generates around £6.5bn of sales revenue annually.

Two other new priority sectors identified are construction and tourism. These join a group of six existing priority sectors already identified, including energy, finance and IT.
