

## DOES YOUR FOOD AND DRINK BUSINESS MEET THE REQUIRED 'SCORES ON THE DOORS' FOOD HYGIENE STANDARD?

Does your food and drink business meet the food hygiene requirements?

**What does this mean for you and your business?** All food and drink businesses must display its food hygiene rating 'The scores on the doors' in a prominent place that is visible to the consumer before or as they enter the premises.

Food businesses are rated between 0 which means 'urgent improvement necessary' to the operation of the business, to 5 which is 'very good' based on your compliance with the food hygiene laws.

**What are the benefits of meeting these requirements?** Displaying a higher food rating allows customers the opportunity to make a more informed choice about where to eat or shop for food. So ensuring that your business is high up on the hygiene ratings will mean that you get more business, which results in more profitability!

**What do I need to do?** Supported by funding through The Welsh Food & Drinks Skills Project\* a number of training courses will be delivered by our approved training provider, Food Business Assistance (FBA) over the coming months across Wales.

The course will help businesses achieve the highest rating possible, as well as helping businesses already with a good rating to retain it and improve upon it where applicable.

The course will cost **£42 + VAT** per person (this figure includes funding support of 70% which is available through the Welsh Food & Drink Skills Project for eligible businesses (standard courses normally cost £140 + VAT per person).

The course can help you understand what is required of your operation to ensure you meet the standard when the Environmental Health Officer (EHO) inspects your business. Food Business Assistance (FBA) can explain the procedures and criteria's that the EHO looks for during the inspection. FBA will let you know how the scheme works, what the inspectors evaluate and how many points are awarded for what aspect of your operation.
