

ARE YOU READY FOR THE NEW FOOD LABELLING LAWS?

Are you ready for the new food labelling laws? Food labelling laws are changing! The European Commission's new regulation on The Food Information for Consumers Regulations comes into force on the 12 December 2014. No matter what type of food and drink business you operate the new regulations are going to have an impact... and things are going to have to change!

What does this mean for you and your business? Well, after that date all food products packed or sold in the UK must be compliant with the new regulations. The regulation sets out the requirements for what must be, and what can be on a food label; the size and layout requirements of the information displayed on packaging; it specifies what allergens and nutritional information should be included and how they should be displayed.

Even if you operate a restaurant or café, or serve food, your business must provide clear, accurate and complete information about the presence of any allergens listed in the regulations to the consumers.

What businesses are affected? Regardless of size, this covers all food businesses at all stages of the food supply chain, from producers, to handlers to servers of food. Everyone should be aware of how the new regulations will affect their business.

What will happen if I don't comply? This could result in prosecutions by Trading Standards, and any packaging that doesn't meet the requirements after the 12 December 2014 cannot be used. Failure to provide information, the provision of inaccurate information or refusing to provide the relevant information in your business is an offence.

What do I need to do? Supported by funding through The Welsh Food & Drinks Skills Project* a number of training courses will be delivered by approved training provider - Food Business Assistance (FBA) over the coming months across Wales, responding to the ever changing demands of new food labelling laws faced by food and drink businesses in Wales.

What courses are available? *Level 2 Food Labelling*

The course will cost **£42 + VAT** per person (this figure includes funding support of 70% which is available through the Welsh Food & Drink Skills Project for eligible businesses (standard courses normally cost £140 + VAT per person).

The Level 2 Food Labelling course can help you understand what is required of your business; from helping you understand how to calculate the nutritional information in your recipe to what information you need to display or make available to consumers.
