The Farm Enterprises

300 Lleyn Pedigree Ewes

20 Devon Reds

Haylage Enterprise

Livery Yard

8000 hens

(one flock of 6000 and another of
2000)

Egg Production

Birds bought in at 16 weeks of age

Birds start laying at 20 weeks of age

Lay until 72 weeks of age

Peak production is from 25 weeks to 30 weeks of age

They will peak at 95%

Egg Production continued

When they leave their production is at 75%

Egg Size increases with age

Egg shell quality decreases with age

Birds eat 130 g/day/bird

Husbandry of the Hens

Monitor water and feed intake

Egg size

Light management

Litter

Ventilation

Nest Box training

Pest and Diseases

Maintain Machinery and equipment

PACKING OF EGGS

Eggs delivered in packing room on conveyor belt

All eggs packed daily

All eggs are stamped

Cyw Hapus eggs are candled and graded

Eggs are stored in a cooler on pallets of either 540 or 720 Dozen

Destination of Egg Sales

4000 Dozen eggs produced weekly

3000 Dozen sold to national packer

1000 Dozen sold privately
